Akbar Waljee, MD is an Associate Professor in Internal Medicine with the Division of Gastroenterology at the University of Michigan. He is also a Staff Physician & Research Scientist and Director of the Inflammatory Bowel Disease Program with Veterans Affairs Ann Arbor Healthcare System.

Dr. Waljee's research focuses on the management of medical and surgical therapies in inflammatory bowel disease, the quality of life issues faced by those with these chronic conditions, and the use of novel machine learning techniques as decision support systems. He is working on the development of "targeted-prevention" prediction tools and decision support systems to facilitate the delivery of timely and cost-effective therapy for "High Expense, Low Prevalence" diseases, with a focus on inflammatory bowel disease.

Dr. Waljee received his medical degree from Emory University and completed his residency program there. He completed his Postdoctoral Fellowship training with the Department of Gastroenterology at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor.
