Terrisca Des Jardins is Administrator for Physician Organization of Michigan Accountable Care Organization (POM ACO), one of the nation's largest Medicare Shared Savings Program ACOs, managing over \$1 billion of healthcare spending.

Ms. Des Jardins also serves as Advisory Consultant to the Greater Detroit Area Health Council, and recently finished serving as one of seven national Bruce Bradley Fellows for The Leapfrog Group. She directed the Southeast Michigan Beacon Community initiative, one of a handful of federal programs testing a variety of HIT and HIE pilots toward leveraging technology for clinical and health delivery transformation. Its focus was on social determinants alongside traditional medical approaches, the strategic inclusion of a population-based data repository alongside information exchange, and supporting providers with dedicated and focused "boots on the ground" assistance in their journey toward value-based care.
