

## **Wesley Sargent, Jr. EdD**

Wesley Sargent, Jr., EdD, is a health scientist on the Opioid Overdose Health Systems Team in the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Division of Unintentional Injury Prevention. He works on implementing the CDC Guideline for Prescribing Opioids for Chronic Pain in clinical settings, conducting applied healthcare systems research, and providing scientific support to state public health departments.

Dr. Sargent also serves as a Science Officer on the CDC's National Center for Injury Prevention and Control Overdose Prevention for States initiative, where he provides scientific and technical assistance to CDC-funded states. He also assists with Rx drug overdose projects that are designed to address the opioid overdose epidemic at both the health systems and state level.

Dr. Sargent obtained his Doctor of Education in Professional Counseling and Supervision with an emphasis in Program Evaluation from the University of West Georgia.
